CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Students are expected to maintain the high standard of discipline and dignified manner of behaviour inside as well as outside the College campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College and should act in a way that highlights the discipline and esteem of the College.
- 2. A six day working schedule from Monday to Saturday is followed. Classes are scheduled from 10.20 a.m. to 5 p.m. The first period will begin after the prayer song .The students shall stand in attention till the prayer ends.
- 3. All the students are expected to be present in the class -within time and late coming will be penelised. Late coming will also result in loss of attendance for the corresponding hour.
- 4. Students shall rise from their seats when the teacher enters the class room and remain standing till the teacher takes her/his seat or they are allowed by the teacher to sit. Silence shall be observed during class hours.
- 5. Teachers shall be greeted appropriately with "Good Morning Sir/Miss" or " Good Afternoon Sir/Miss" and a "Thank you Sir/Miss" when the teacher enter and leaves the class room.
- 6. No student shall enter or leave the class room when the session is on without the permission of the teacher concerned.
- 7. In the events of Student seminars/class presentations etc., it is compulsory that all the students of the concerned class be present for the entire session.
- . Students can leave the campus during class hours only after getting permission from the Principal, HoD, or the Class teacher
- 9. All students shall leave the classes immediately after 5 p.m. No students shall wander or gather in verandah, corridor, and staircase etc. Do not spend much time in canteen, etc.
- 10. Students shall come to the college in approved uniforms have with blazer over their shirts.

Students shall not make any alterations to the Uniform issued from the college.

11. All the students are expected to attend all college functions in college uniform unless otherwise specified.

All the students shall wear their identity cards, well displayed. Identity badge is a public document and any teaching staff and non teaching staff shall have the right to peruse it. Denial of that alone invites disciplinary action.

- 12. All kinds of tattooing, body piercing, hair styling etc. that goes against the existing social norms and which could go against the academic values will be referred to the class teachers.
- 13. As per the Govt. order, students shall not bring powered vehicles inside the campus.
- 14 Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings to maintain the decorum and, any deviant behavior such as hooting, whistling, loitering etc. will be treated as an instance of indiscipline.
- 15. For independent study, students are expected to use the class rooms, library or the demarcated areas of the academic building and shall not resort to sitting in staircases or circulation areas where they could interfere with the free movement.
- 16. Students are encouraged to make use of the library, common computing facilities and to involve in professional body activities or any program authorized by the college beyond class hours
- 17. All the students are advised to follow the student Mobile phone policy and bring to the notice of the authorities violations if any.
- 1. Students are not permitted to use mobile
- 2. Day scholars carrying mobile phones shall deposit the same in the designated place before 10am and collect the same after 4pm. The mobile phones shall be kept in silent mode while depositing in the designated place.
- 18. Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not put any waste anywhere in the campus except in the waste baskets kept.
- 19. Consumption of chewing gum, panmasala etc. are strictly prohibited.
- 20. It is strongly advised to refrain from activities such as scribbling or noting on walls, door or furniture which could deface the college and destroy the academic ambiance.
- 21. Carefully handle the furniture, equipments, fixtures and appliances of the college and lab. Careless handling/misuse of the above could result personal injuries or damage to property Follow safety precautions near moving machines and electrical installations.

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In the event of damage of property, the responsible students will have to bear the cost of replacement/repair with fine.

- 22. Students are not permitted to arrange any unauthorized celebrations and decorations of any magnitude in the campus.
- 23. Students are expected to make use of academic, co-curricular and extracurricular facilities available to the optimum levels. This will certainly make them physically fit, academically competent, mentally alert and socially sensitive.
- 24. Students who intend to represent the college in intercollegiate events shall take prior permission from the concerned head of the department and the selection will be based on parameters such as academic performance, attendance, character, existing academic pressure and competence of the student in the proposed event for participatio
- 25. During internal examinations of 2 Hr period, students are not allowed to leave the hall within one hour from the beginning of the exam, and students have to occupy the seat 5 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 26. Political activity in any form is not permitted in the College campus. Unauthorized meetings, propaganda work, processions or fund collections are forbidden within the College, hostels, and outside the college.
- 27. Misbehavior towards girl students, use of threat or violence against members of the staff or fellow students will be considered as very serious cases of misconduct.
- 28. Pay fees, mess bills etc. in advance or in time, which will avoid fines.
- 29. Any violation of the above rules will invite penalty in the form of warning, fine, bringing of parents or any course of corrective measure as found suitable by any staff member or higher authority of the College.
